- 1. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 14th March, 2017
- 1.1 Minutes of the Finance Committee meeting held on 14.3.2017 were circulated to all the members. After a brief discussion the minutes of the previous Finance Committee meeting held on 14th March, 2017 were confirmed.

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- 2. TO CONSIDER THE REVISION OF RATES OF REMUNERATION PAYABLE AT DIFFERENT LEVELS FOR CONDUCT OF EXAMINATIONS IN THE UNIVERSITY
- 2.1 The recommendations (at Appendix B) of the committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vicechancellor to consider the revision of rates of remuneration payable at different levels for conduct of Examinations in the University of Delhi along with the Annexures 1,2 and 3 were placed before the Finance Committee. The Dean (Examinations) briefed the Finance Committee on the existing and proposed rates of remuneration payable at different levels for conduct of examination in the University as per schedule of remuneration mentioned below:

The rates of remuneration for the members of the visiting team were last revised from Rs.300/- per session to Rs. 500/- per session on 7^{th} October, 2014 as per the approval of the competent authority.

The Dean (Examination) further informed that the revised rates may be applicable from Examination scheduled in May/June 2017 as recommended by the committee for revision of rates of remuneration. Moreover, with regard to source of funds for meeting the additional expenditure to be incurred resulting from the proposed revision of rates, the committee recommended that the additional expenditure on this count may be met from the funds generated/received from the School of Open Learning i.e. Rs.100/- per student.

After a detailed discussion, the Finance committee considered the recommendations of the committee for the revision of rates of remuneration payable at different levels for conduct of examination as above and recommended for the approval of the Executive Council.
